Monte Vista Academic Boosters is a parent-led nonprofit organization established to support academic excellence at Monte Vista High School. It is because of the generous donations made by our parent community during our Fall and Spring Campaigns, in addition to the Corporate Matching funds received, that we are able to accomplish our goals and support our Monte Vista students. Here is what we do:

Support academic excellence by funding additional class sections. MV students have the opportunity to take courses that offer the breadth and depth in many subject areas including over 30 AP and Honors classes, band, choir, dance, theater, photography, and many more.

Fund additional hours for the Monte Vista College and Career Advisor to bring the position to a full-time status allowing for more hours to coordinate visits from college admission personnel and advise our students on their post-secondary options. Additionally, we work with the College and Career Advisor to co-sponsor the SRVUSD College Fair held every fall.

Coordinate test prep opportunities through Classes and Testing Committee

- AP practice tests

- College application essay writing

Acknowledge students' achievements and hard work via our Honor Roll program. Honor roll certificates and candy are provided to students earning a 3.5 GPA each semester. Additionally, we provide eligible graduating seniors with the red braided Honor Cords worn during the graduation ceremony.

Award educational grants to provide additional resources to our students. In the past, the Administration has made requests for various educational grants to assist our faculty and students. We are proud that past projects have funded the following:
