1. Make a SketchNote for a particular chapter or unit

2. For info you have to memorize - use the

Leitner flashcard system:

- Create flashcards
- As you use the flashcards, if you get the answer right move it to the bottom of your pile. If you get it wrong, put it a few cards from the top so that you are forced to review it again and again until you get it

3. Use the Study Guide

- WITHOUT your notes in front of you, write out the answers to as many questions as possible
- Use your notes to check your answers (and correct, if needed) and to answer the other questions
- The next day, repeat (until you can correctly answer all the questions without your notes)
