Parking in the Monte Vista student lot is by permit only. Parking permits are \$150 for the school year and are sold to Seniors and Juniors only. Students must have a current valid driver's license in order to purchase a permit and carry liability insurance. Having a permit does not guarantee a parking space will be available. The parking permit is valid only for the vehicle listed on this application and is non-transferrable. The permit must be attached by campus monitor to the passenger side on the inside, lower corner of the front window. The permit number must be clearly visible. Students who fail to comply with the Parking Permit Rules & Regulations are at risk of suspension and/or revocation of the permit without a refund of the fee. Parking permits are issued to a specific vehicle(s). Vehicles not parked legally and vehicles without a valid permit will be subject to a \$35.00 citation. This citation is enforceable by Contra Costa County and the DMV and could result in vehicle registration being withheld if the fine is not paid. Increased fines and/or towing may result in non-compliance of parking rules.

NOTE: False information on this application could result in the loss of the parking privilege.

# MVHS Parking Permit Rules & Regulations

Parking in the student lot is by permit only. All senior and junior students who wish to apply for a parking permit must complete an application. Parking in the Monte Vista High School lot is a privilege accompanied by the expectation of responsible behavior on school grounds. The Administration of Monte Vista High School may revoke and/or suspend the permit at any time (without refund of fee) if the following school regulations are not followed.

- Students must drive safely, in accordance with all State and Local Vehicle Code regulations, maintaining a safe speed (5 mph or less) and safe conduct at all times.
- The parking permit must be visible at all times through the front window to be valid.
- No parking is allowed at any time in driveways, fire lanes, staff or visitor areas, Yellow or Red curbs, or on dirt designated as staging areas for construction vehicles.
- Student vehicles must park facing into spaces.
- Vehicles that are illegally parked are subject to ticketing or towing at owner's expense.
- Drivers who continually violate these parking rules will have the parking pass revoked and are subject to school disciplinary action (Ed Code 48990 subsection K).
- Security for parked vehicles requires that no student is to be in the parking lot during the school day. Do not use your vehicle as a locker. Do not loiter in the parking lot.
- If your vehicle is parked on campus legally or not, it is subject to search by the administration or a designee.
- Any Monte Vista student caught on school grounds or SRVUSD property (during and after school hours, sports events or extracurricular activities) in direct possession of (personal possession, possession of or in a backpack or vehicle) controlled substances (alcohol, drugs, tobacco, or other illegal controlled substances) will forfeit his or her right to park in the Monte Vista parking lot. Discipline as outlined in the Monte Vista Student Handbook will also apply.
- Students will treat fellow students and all Monte Vista High School Employees with respect and courtesy at all times in accordance with the provisions in the student handbook. Student drivers may lose parking privileges for adverse behavior.
- Permits MAY NOT be transferred from one vehicle to another. Permits are issued to a specific vehicle.
- If a temporary permit is needed, in cases of car repair or to switch a vehicle with a parent, it is the responsibility of the student to go to the main office to acquire a temporary parking pass prior to the start of school. If a valid temporary permit is not posted on the dashboard of the vehicle, a \$35.00 parking ticket may be issued.
